

## *Valley Bible Church - Sermon Study Questions*

### **Study Aid for the Sermon from March 30, 2014 An Angelic Proclamation Concerning Hell Revelation 14:9-11**

#### **Observing the text**

Read Revelation 14:12-13 and make observations of the text. How do these verses fit into the flow of the text?

What does it mean to be blessed (Revelation 14:12)?

Who is it that is blessed according to Revelation 14:12?

What characteristics of their life merited such a blessing (Revelation 14:12)?

What characteristics in their death demonstrate that they are blessed (Revelation 14:13)?

#### **Applying the sermon**

Evaluate the message of the eternal gospel given by the angel in Revelation 14:6-7 (cf. Romans 3:10; 5:8; 6:23; Ephesians 2:8-9; John 1:12). Have you personally received this message of the eternal gospel? If so, describe how this came about.

What evidence exists in your life that demonstrates you have embraced this message of the eternal gospel?

Who is responsible to carry forth the message of the eternal gospel to the world today?  
How are you personally involved in carrying forth this message of the eternal gospel?

Is the message of the eternal gospel taken as good or bad news by those who hear it?  
What does the proclamation concerning eternal hell (Revelation 14:9-11) say to those who reject the eternal gospel?

If you have embraced the message of the eternal gospel, what should your response be to this third angelic proclamation concerning hell (Revelation 14:9-11)?
