Revelation 14:12-13

Observing the text

Read Revelation 14:12-13 and make observations of the text. How do these verses fit into the flow of the text?

What does it mean to be blessed (Revelation 14:12)?

Who is it that is blessed according to Revelation 14:12?

What characteristics of their life merited such a blessing (Revelation 14:12)?

What characteristics in their death demonstrate that they are blessed (Revelation 14:13)?

Applying the sermon

In light of your present circumstances, can you call yourself blessed? Why or why not?

Rate your level of perseverance. What do you need to strengthen your confidence?

What is there in Revelation 14:12-13 that would give you strength and encouragement?

How are you daily striving to keep the commandments of God?

What earthly trials are you longing to receive rest from in heaven?

What labors or deeds exist in your life that demonstrate your ongoing perseverance in the faith?
