Study Aid for the Sermon from July 13, 2014 Christ is Superior to Moses Hebrews 3:15-19

Observing the text

Read Hebrews 3:15-19 and make as many observations as possible. How does Hebrews 3:15-19 fit into the flow of the passage?

Read about the exodus experience of Israel in Exodus 17 and Numbers 14-20.

Read what King David wrote to Israel in response to their earlier exodus experience as quoted in Hebrews 3:7-11.

What was the question the author asked in verse 16, and what was his answer?

What was the question the author asked in verse 17, and what was his answer?

What was the question the author asked in verse 18, and what was his answer?

What was the author's final conclusion in verse 19?

Applying the sermon

How does Israel's past failure in the wilderness aid your ability to take the exhortations of Hebrews 3:12-14 to heart?

How does the way God dealt with Israel in judgment motivate you to listen to the voice of God?

What do you perceive to be the connection between your profession of faith and your attention to the voice of God? How is this relationship between your faith and your listening to God's Word manifested?

Why is the root cause of your past times failure to obey the Lord rooted in a lack of belief? How does this understanding help you to persevere as partakers of Christ?
