Study Aid for the Sermon from September 28, 2014 Christ Our Great High Priest Hebrews 4:14-15

Observing the text

Read Hebrews 4:14-16 and make as many observations as possible. How do these fit into the flow of our text?

Has the high priesthood of Christ already been introduced into the book of Hebrews?

What is the significance of the phrase “who has passed through the heavens?”

What does it mean to “hold fast?”

What was their “confession?”

What is the importance of Christ, our high priest, being able to sympathize with us?

What does it mean that Christ was “tempted in all things as we are?”

Applying the sermon

What is the significance of Jesus, the Son of God, being the great high priest and seated at the right hand of His Father in heaven?

How have you seen yourself holding fast to your confession during life’s trials?

In what aspect of your life do you see your faith being tested? How does knowing that Jesus can sympathize with our weakness help you?

Take some time to thank God for your great high priest and for the comfort He brings to us in the midst of testings.
