Study Aid for the Sermon from November 2, 2014 Christ, the Qualified and Perfect High Priest Hebrews 5:7-10

Observing the text

Read Hebrews 5:7-10 and make as many observations as possible. How do these verses fit into the flow of the passage?

What does the word “piety” mean?

What does it mean that Christ “learned obedience from the things that He suffered?”

What does Christ being “made perfect” refer to?

In what sense is Christ the “source of eternal salvation.”

Why is Christ being designated as a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek significant?

Applying the sermon

As you consider Christ’s path to glory in Hebrews 5:8, how does this compare with your life?

How have you learned obedience from the things which you have suffered?

What present opportunities exist for you to learn obedience in your life?

Take a moment to ask for the Lord’s help as you seek to honor Christ as you walk the path available to you through Christ our great heavenly high priest.
