Study Aid for the Sermon from March 29, 2015 The Greatness of Melchizedek Hebrews 7:1-3

Observing the text

Read Hebrews 7:1-3 and make as many observations as possible. How do these verses fit into the flow of the passage?

What can you learn about Salem from Psalm 76:2?

What did the author mean when he said that Melchizedek was “without father”, “without mother” and “without genealogy?”

What did the author mean when he referred to Melchizedek as “having neither beginning of days nor end of life.”

What is the significance of the phrase “but made like the Son of God?”

What is the significance of the word “perpetually?”

Applying the sermon

Why do you believe that God included a narrative of Melchizedek’s meeting with Abraham in Genesis 14:17-20?

How does God’s inclusion of this narrative support the divine inspiration of the Bible?

How do other biblical types support divine inspiration? Is there any other biblical type that supports divine inspiration more so than that of Melchizedek?
