Study Aid for the Sermon from February 28, 2016 Christ's Sacrifice Takes Away Sin Hebrews 10:11-18

Observing the text

Why did the author make it a point to establish the fact that after Christ offered His once for all sacrifice that He “sat down at the right hand of God” (Hebrews 10:11-12)?

How long do the scriptures indicate that Christ will remain seated at God's right hand (Hebrews 10:13)?

Explain the importance of Christ's once for all sacrifice (Hebrews 10:14)?

What Old Testament scripture did the author use in order to confirm the impact of Christ's once for all sacrifice (Hebrews 10:15-17)?

So if Christ's once for all sacrifice for sin has made it possible for those who have been sanctified to have their sins and lawless deeds remembered no more, what is the implication of this (Hebrews 10:18)?

Applying the sermon

Why does Christ's sacrifice take away all sin for all time?

Can a person benefit from Christ's sacrifice without exercising faith in Christ?

Why will a person who exercises faith in Christ be made forever acceptable and forever have access to God in Christ?

What is the difference between having access to God and taking advantage of that access?

If you believe that you have access to God through faith in Christ, are you presently taking advantage of that access? If you are not taking advantage of that access, why is that?
