Study Aid for the Sermon from June 12, 2016 Let Us Consider How to Stimulate One Another Hebrews 10:24-25

Observing the text

Why would the exhortation to “consider how to stimulate one another to love and good works” immediately follow the exhortation “to hold fast the confession of our hope?”

Would seeking to respond to this exhortation to “consider how to stimulate one another to love and good works” require a concerted and consistent effort?

What would be the benefits to a church if the whole of that church would consciously seek to respond to this exhortation?

Would those seeking to respond to this exhortation need to make the gathering together with fellow believers a high priority?

Applying the sermon

How will the members of our church be better protected from falling away if more and more of our members begin to stimulate one another to love and good works?

Do you believe that you are presently one of those individuals within our church who is considering how to stimulate one another to love and good works?

Can you presently think of individual members within our church who are not committed to unconditionally loving the members of our church and doing good works toward them?

What can you do on their behalf to stimulate those who are not committed?

Why would those who are struggling to maintain their attendance at our gatherings be of particular concern for us?
