Observing the text

Why did Paul choose to make his testimony the subject of his address?

How did Paul craft what he says according to his audience in Acts 22:1-21 (cf. Acts 9:1-19; 26:1-23)?

How would you respond to someone who would use Acts 22:16 to teach that baptism produces salvation?

What can you learn about telling the story of your conversion from Paul's address to the Jews?

Applying the sermon

Why do you think your testimony could be helpful for people to understand more about Jesus?

Think of the last time you shared your testimony with someone. How did you select what part of your life you spoke about that might have been particularly significant to the person that you were talking to?

Have you been baptized after you believed in Christ? If not, speak with one of our church leaders about baptism.

In what ways have you been participating in God's plan to reach the Gentiles for Christ?
