The Arrival of Paul in Caesarea
Acts 23:23-35**

Observing the text

Why were 470 military men necessary to transport Paul from Jerusalem to Caesarea (23:23)?

How did Luke get a copy of the letter that a Roman Commander sent to a Roman Governor (23:25-30)?

Evaluate the commander's report in light of the events of Acts 21:27-23:22.

What do you know of Felix, the Roman Governor? How is that seen in Acts 23:33-35?

Applying the sermon

As we have seen the events of Paul's life, consider the events of your lifetime. What are the significant turning points?

How did you view these events as they were transpiring? Compare your view of them with what you think of them now in retrospect.

How was God faithful to deliver you through the circumstances of your life? Give thanks to Him for what He has done.

How has your reflection on God's faithfulness helped you to trust Him for what you are currently facing?

How has Paul's life of service to the Lord motivated you to be similarly steadfast in your commitment of faith?
